Communication Services contributes to the mission of the Congrégation de Notre-Dame by facilitating both internal and external communication. The members of the team meet the needs of the entire community by: writing and translating numerous texts; providing secretarial services; taking notes during international committee meetings; editing and preparing documents for printing; transmitting information about the Congregation via press releases, websites, social media or print media advertising. Among other initiatives, Communication Services designs and maintains the Congregation's website and social media.

To Experience Internationality

The Congrégation de Notre-Dame is present in eight countries and communicates in four official languages: French, English, Japanese and Spanish. Communication Services translators are called upon to write and translate different types of texts such as administrative documents, minutes of meetings, circulars, reflections and prayers. They are also required to work on articles pertaining to social justice, documents relative to Associate Relationship activities, data sheets from Archives Services as well as news and information posted on the website or social media, and more.
